Submission Guidelines

Manuscript Format:

- Length: 6,000–9,500 words for research articles, 1,000–1,500 words for book reviews or brief communications.
- Font: Arial, 12 pt, 1.5 line spacing, with 2.5 cm margins on all sides.
- **Style**: Use *The Chicago Manual of Style*, 17th Edition for citations/references.

Abstract:

- Structured abstract (200–250 words), summarising research objectives, methods, findings, and contributions.
- Include up to five keywords.

Figures and Tables:

• Submit separately in an editable format (Excel, PowerPoint, or .eps).

Language:

- Manuscripts must be in British English, but formal names and references should retain their original language unless an official translation exists.
- Editorial Process
- All submissions undergo an anonymous double-blind peer review.
- Authors will receive feedback within six weeks.
- Upon acceptance, authors will pay a \$30 processing fee.
